Black LisTEAd

Caulfield's **Black LisTEAd** plays tribute to the infamous Hollywood Blacklist featured on Caulfield's very own mural. ICED from the industry for their supposed radical political views, our blacklisted icons were banned from working for all major Hollywood studios in 1947. Our mural is Caulfield's nod to a powerful group of individuals who helped shape both this town and country.

Ginger in the Rye

The *Catcher in the Rye*, written by J.D. Salinger, has been accredited as one of the best novels of the twentieth century. With a talented eye to both spot and dismiss "phoniness", the novel's protagonist, Holden Caulfield, is a classic icon for teenage rebellion. He also happens to be the inspiration behind Caulfield's Bar and Dining Room and our popular cocktail, **Ginger in the Rye!**

The Chaplin

Famous for his character "The Tramp"—the distinguished man with a bowler hat, mustache and cane—Charlie Chaplin was an iconic figure of the silent-film era that elevated the industry in a way few could have ever imagined. While his methods may have been unorthodox at the time, Chaplin's comical yet subtle impressions aptly coined him one of Hollywood's first superstars. Twisted Hemmingway

Ernest Hemingway is most commonly known as one of the 20th century's finest American authors. Less frequently referenced sources construe Hemmingway was also a bullfighting enthusiast, cat-lover, world-renowned fisherman, sub-chaser, and for our purposes here, a rather prodigious drinker. Caulfield's **Twisted Hemmingway** celebrates the man who's "Silver Tongue" ultimately landed him on Hollywood's Blacklist.

Jack Kerouac was an American writer best known for the novel *On the Road*, an American classic that pioneered the Beat Generation in the 1950s.
